Global Politics Seasonal Schools (GPSS) are innovative and intensive short-term certificate programs in various locations all around the world. Jointly organized by the Center for Global Politics at Freie Universität Berlin and a renowned partner university abroad, each school brings together highly qualified students and first-rate scholars to exchange and debate global political and economic phenomena.

## EUROPE, ASIA, AND THE MIDDLE EAST

Lasting up to two weeks, Global Politics Seasonal Schools are held in dynamic cities like Hanoi, Phnom Penh, Amman, Tehran, and Shanghai. The seminars comprise state of the art teaching methods, ranging from working groups to simulation games and online discussions. Outside the classroom, we offer an exciting supporting program, including company visits, roundtable discussions with experts, and excursions.

## STUDENTS

Up to 30 participants are admitted to each Seasonal School. The majority of seats are reserved for applicants from the partner countries and that region but a small number of students from Germany and other countries are also admitted. After completing their course, students are welcome to join our active network of over 1000 alumni from all around the world.
